

External Record	External Records are the similar Products sold to Meijer by multiple Vendors. This is the version of the product created and submitted for proposal (by the Vendor or MSA on behalf of the Vendor).	
	 When searched, External Records are displayed in dark blue color. 	
	■ TESLA/REAL TO REEL 2	
	The ID for External Records are prefixed with EXT followed by 6 digits. Example – EXT-XXXXXX	
Internal Record	One or more External Records are linked to a single sellable item that is referred to as an Internal Record. There can be multiple number of Internal Records of a Product. This is the version of the record edited by the MSA.	
	When searched, Internal Records are displayed in light blue color.	
	■ TESLA/REAL TO REEL 2	
	The ID for Internal Records are prefixed with INT followed by 6 digits. Example – INT-XXXXXX	
Golden Record	Internal Records are enhanced by the MSAs to form a Golden Record . There is always an one-to-one relationship between the Internal and Golden Records. The Golden Record is a sellable item and is passed to PMM, CFD, and other downstream Meijer systems. This is the completed and final version of the product.	
	When searched, Internal Records are displayed in yellow color.	
	■ TESLA/REAL TO REEL 2	
	The ID for Golden Records are prefixed with GR followed by 6 digits. Example – GR-XXXXXX	











Hierarchy of the Products in PIM.




24. The **External Product Hierarchy** screen is displayed with the details.






25. Click the **Right Arrow** to collapse the side panel.




- 26. The **Stibo User Web UI** screen is displayed with the following widgets:

 Click **User Settings** to log out or select another Vendor number associated with your ID.







2. The **User Settings** section is displayed.

- D. Select Locale allows you to select your preferred language.





1. Click the **Help** option from the side panel.




2. The **PIM for Retail** Help page is displayed.

Standard Completeness – It displays the completeness of the Product setup in percentage.



Required Attributes in the Required Tab (Mandatory Fields):				
MSRP – It is the Manufacturer's Suggested Retail Price (MSRP). It is the price at which the manufacturer recommends that the retailer sell the Product. It should be a numeric value.	MSRP (\$N.NN) 9.98			
Buyer Number – It identifies the Buyer responsible for purchase and sales of a specific Product.	Buyer Number 350			
Fsvp Classification – Foreign Supplier Verification Program (FSVP) Classification is used to distinguish between items that are meant for human and/or animal consumption, and those that are not.	Fsvp Classification

Vendor Workflow


Proposal – This is where External Records are stored before they are submitted after Initiation. If there are External Records in Proposal, they have not been submitted to Meijer to review.




Enrichment – This is where External Records are stored once they have been submitted from Proposal to Meijer. They will live here until Meijer approves the record. Changes can be made in Enrichment any time before the record is approved.



NOTE: Once you have made changes in Enrichment, click Save only. If submitted from Enrichment, the record will disappear from this folder and no updates can be made before Meijer approves the record, or sends it back for Rework




Rework – This is where External Records are stored if the Meijer team sends the record back for Rework. Updates can be made to the record in this folder and then submitted back to be reviewed again by Meijer.





Rejected – This is where External Records are stored if the Meijer team Rejects the record. These will not be able to be resubmitted.
